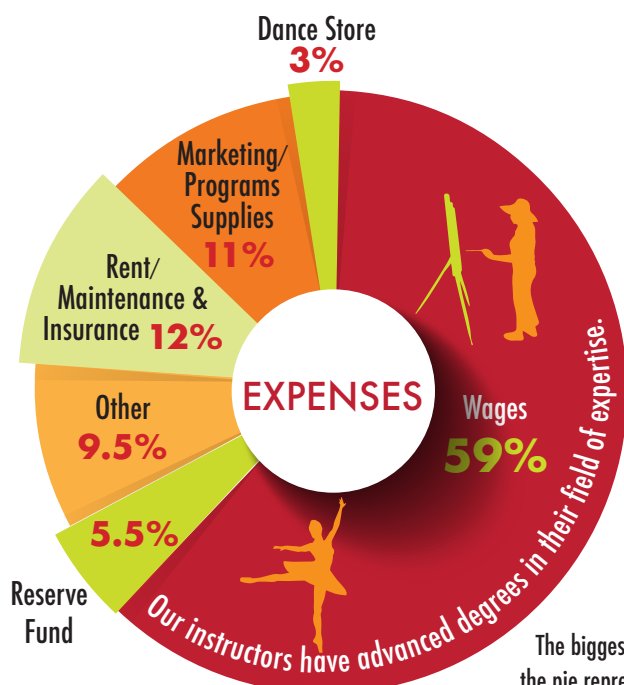

WE ARE THE ARTS ORGANIZATION THAT:

- bases class fees on income and family size and offers additional scholarships for children who live in poverty.
- keeps programs costs low for families by providing dance and theater costumes through rentals instead of purchase (\$15 fee instead of \$75) and setting tickets low at \$5-6 instead of \$15-\$20
- is a vibrant place of diversity and inclusion

79% of the children we serve receive some level of financial assistance in order to participate.

ARTS EDUCATION

We provide programming in art, dance and theater for ages 2 1/2 to adult. Year round. 6 days a week. Jackson School of the Arts is the largest provider of arts programming in Jackson County.

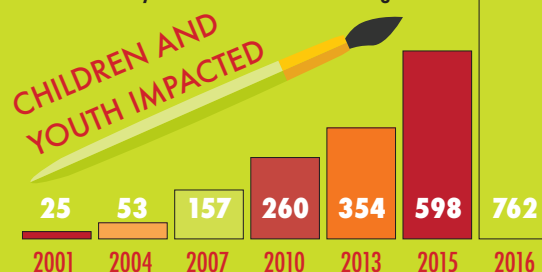
145 different classes and programs run all year long
