This application helps us offer reduced monthly fees for those who need it. All information is confidential and only used for internal and funding purposes.

### Before You Apply, Please Know:

- You will still be responsible for your registration fee and a portion of tuition each month.
- **Tuition is due by the 1st of the month.** Late payments may result in a \$10 fee and could affect continued support.
- Families can receive tuition support for up to five ongoing weekly classes per child for the school year (September through August). If you're interested in more than five, we'll do our best to work with you based on available funding.
- This support runs from September 1, 2025 to August 31, 2026. Families must reapply each year.
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
